Oliver Chimney Sweeps' heavy duty vacuum creates a powerful tornado like vacuum within the firebox. All soot coming down goes directly into the vacuum equipment. There is absolutely no mess.

The damper is removed, straightened, lubricated and replaced. When completed, sticky and poor fitting dampers move easily and fit properly.

The smoke chamber (the large cavity above the damper) is hand cleaned with a steel brush. Build up is often significant in this area.

The smoke shelf sits at the base of the smoke chamber. Designed to collect settling debris, it all too often becomes the nesting place for racoons, birds, rodents and squirrels.

After cleaning the chimney itself all creosote settles on the smoke shelf. It's important this area be cleaned properly to remove soot, dead animals and nests.

The flue runs from just above the smoke chamber to the top of the chimney. The only way to clean a flue properly is with a steel brush that fits exactly. We drive up the brushes with flexible fibreglass rods which connect together to achieve the desired length. We continue to clean until all obstruction and creosole build up is removed.

Woodstoves and oil flues are cleaned starting at the roof and brushing down. We clean the outside and inside flues. With woodstoves, the pipe leading from the stove to the outside flue is removed. We also clean the inside of the stove. With oil flues, we clean from the furnace damper to the flue, the clean-out drawer and the flue itself.

With our specially designed equipment, we wire-brush and vacuum your chimney efficiently and without mess.
